### Charge(s) and Determination(s):

<b>Charge(s)</b>	<b>Tribunal determination</b>
<p>1. The Respondent (Scott Gilligan) used offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures towards or about a Match Official in breach of section 15.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Number 1 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (<b>Regulations</b>).</p>	<p>1. <u><i>Plea:</i></u> Guilty. <u><i>Finding:</i></u> Guilty</p> <p><u><i>Determination:</i></u> Three (3) match suspension (MMS + 2 Fixtures).</p> <p><u><i>Reasons:</i></u> <i>The GPT found there was clear evidence to show that the Respondent did use "offensive, insulting or abusive language" towards a Match Official. The Respondent has pleaded guilty to the charge and has admitted to the use of the language.</i></p> <p><i>In making the decision, the GPT took into consideration that the Respondent pleaded guilty and took into consideration his record.</i></p> <p><u><i>NB. The suspension is to apply to Coaching on Match Days and sitting on the bench. The respondent is free to attend matches and training sessions.</i></u></p>
<p><b>Costs:</b></p> <p>The Tribunal determined that the costs of the Tribunal, as determined by FNSW, be met by the Respondent.</p>	

Aggrieved parties to a determination of the FNSW General Purposes Tribunal may lodge an appeal to the FNSW Appeals Tribunal in accordance with sections 8.8 and 9.2 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations.
