### Charge(s) and Determination(s):

<b>Charge(s)</b>	<b>Tribunal determination</b>
<p>1. The Respondent (Nassareo Martino) used offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures towards or about a Match Official in breach of section 15.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Number 1 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (<b>Regulations</b>).</p>	<p>1. <u><i>Plea</i></u>: Guilty.</p> <p><u><i>Finding</i></u>: Guilty</p> <p><u><i>Determination</i></u>: MMS + 3 fixtures.</p> <p><u><i>Reasons</i></u>: The Tribunal has accepted the Match Official's version of events and that the Respondent did use the language alleged towards and or about the Match Official.</p> <p>The Respondent appeared before the Tribunal to dispute the use of the word "<i>Cunt</i>". The Respondent sought to rely on the oral Testimony of Mr. Koinis. Unfortunately, for the Respondent the Mr. Koinis did confirm that the use of the word "<i>Cunt</i>" was in the Respondent's vocabulary and the Tribunal is satisfied that he more than likely did use the word towards or about the Match official.</p> <p>In making the determination, The Tribunal takes into account the Respondent's:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) early plea of guilt;</li> <li>b) history before the Tribunal; and</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>c) service to the football community and history in coaching and playing; and</li><li>d) he has stood himself down for one match on his own accord.</li></ul>
