### Charge(s) and Determination(s):

<b>Charge(s)</b>	<b>Tribunal determination</b>
<p>1. The Respondent (Ivan Galic) used offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures towards or about a Match Official in breach of section 15.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Number 1 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (<b>Regulations</b>).</p>	<p>1. <u><i>Plea:</i></u> Guilty. <u><i>Finding:</i></u> Guilty <u><i>Determination:</i></u> Three (3) match suspension (MMS + 2 Fixtures). <u><i>Reasons:</i></u> <i>The GPT found there was sufficient evidence to show that the Respondent did use language that was offensive, insulting or abusive towards the Match Official. The Respondent has pleaded guilty to the charge.</i></p>
<p>2. The Respondent (Ivan Galic) used threatening or intimidating language or conduct towards a Match Official in breach of section 15.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Number 5 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (<b>Regulations</b>).</p>	<p>2. <u><i>Plea:</i></u> Guilty. <u><i>Finding:</i></u> Guilty <u><i>Determination:</i></u> Twelve (12) match suspension (MMS + 11 Fixtures). <u><i>Reasons:</i></u> <i>The GPT found there was sufficient evidence to show that the Respondent did use threatening and intimidating towards the Match Official. The Respondent has pleaded guilty to the charge.</i></p>

<p>3. The Respondent (Ivan Galic) failed to follow any reasonable direction of an Official or Football NSW employee or representative in relation to conduct and/or behavior at a Match in breach of section 15.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Number 8 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (<b>Regulations</b>).</p>	<p>3. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty <u>Determination</u>: Two (2) Fixtures.</p> <p><u>Reasons</u>: <i>The GPT found there was sufficient evidence to show that the Respondent did fail to follow the reasonable direction of an Official or Football NSW employee or representative in relation to his conduct and/or behavior at a Match. The Respondent has pleaded guilty to the charge.</i></p> <p><u>The GPT took into consideration the Respondent's record when assessing the sanctions at the lower end of the recommended suspensions.</u></p> <p><b><i>In determining the sanction, the GPT determined that the suspensions for Charges 1 and 2 to be served concurrently given that they were for the same conduct and the sanction for Charge 3 is cumulative.</i></b></p> <p><b><i>Therefore, the total suspension to be served by the Respondent is Fourteen (14) fixtures.</i></b></p> <p><u>NB. The suspension is to apply to all football activities.</u></p>
<p><b>Costs:</b></p> <p>The Tribunal determined that the costs of the Tribunal, as determined by FNSW, be met by the Respondent.</p>	

Aggrieved parties to a determination of the FNSW General Purposes Tribunal may lodge an appeal to the FNSW Appeals Tribunal in accordance with sections 8.8 and 9.2 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations. Any appeal must be submitted by completing the online Notice of Appeal form (Prescribed Form 12 – available on the FNSW website or by clicking [here](#)) and lodging the relevant Application Fee (\$750) within 7 working days of this determination being issued.
