The Respondent (Blaze Stevanovski) having been expelled from the Field of Play, displayed unsportsmanlike or unprofessional behavior in breach of Section 15.4(d), Schedule 3: Table C, Number 7 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (Regulations).</p>	<p>1. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty.</p> <p><u>Determination</u>: Four (4) fixtures suspension.</p> <p><u>Reasons</u>: <i>The GPT accepted the Respondent's guilty plea having determined that his behavior was unprofessional.</i></p> <p><i>The Respondent is suspended for four (4) Fixtures for the offence under Charge 1.</i></p> <p><i>The GPT applied a discount of one (1) Fixture due to the Respondent's apology and early guilty plea.</i></p> <p>The Respondent is therefore required to serve the remaining three (3) fixtures suspension from all football activities including spectating.</p>
<p>Costs:</p> <p>The Tribunal determined that the costs of the Tribunal, as determined by FNSW, be met by the Respondent.</p>
